This workshop offers an introduction to landscape oil painting, with a focus on key aspects of composition, colour mixing, and brush handling. It is suitable for beginners as well as those seeking to strengthen foundational skills.

Participants will study reproductions of 20th-century landscape painters to understand their approaches to composition and colour, and then apply these insights in a guided study based on a reference photograph. Special attention will be given to mixing colours for compositional elements such as water, sky, and grass, using an extended palette to achieve a broad range of hues and rich colour harmonies.

All materials are provided. Bring your own brushes.

Topics covered include:

- Materials and tools for oil painting: surfaces, brushes, mediums, and palette organisation
- Understanding value and shape when blocking in a composition
- Using an extended palette to improve colour mixing and tonal range
- Techniques for layering paint and developing texture
- Drawing insight from 20th century landscape painters' work to inform your own decision-making

By the end of the workshop, participants will have completed a small landscape study and developed a clearer understanding of how to continue working with oils independently.
